

# CHIPPENDALE GREEN THE GREEN HEART OF CENTRAL PARK



Covering more than 6,400 sqm, Chippendale Green is a new public park built by Frasers and Sekisui House and dedicated to the City of Sydney.

Chippendale Green was designed by Jeppe Aagaard Andersen (Denmark) and Turf Design (Australia).

- Expansive lawn area with shaded seating
- Established trees, including a feature fig tree
- A central pedestrian boulevard, connecting the park to Broadway (pedestrian access from August 2013)
- Water feature and water terraces
- Water detention tank to accommodate stormwater as part of Central Park's water recycling system
- *Halo*, a 13 metre high wind-powered artwork, by Jennifer Turpin and Michaelie Crawford
- Temporary public artworks on the Brewery Yard, part of the *Artists in Residence* collection
